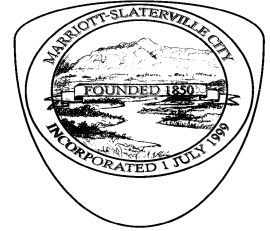

Remember it is illegal to park on the side of the road during and after a snowstorm event because Weber County will be snow plowing the roads. Vehicles parked on the road-side during or after a snowstorm may be towed or ticketed at the owner's expense.

Weber County will plow most traveled roads first, subdivisions and the least traveled road last. Home and business owners with sidewalk are responsible to remove the snow from the sidewalk within 24-hours after a snowstorm.
