## April Gardening Tips

1. Clean weeds from flower beds and trim perennials.
2. Trim ornamental grasses as short as possible.
3. Prune roses back to 24 inches, unless leafed out, then prune less aggressively.
4. Prune out dead wood and crossing branches from roses and shrubs.
5. Remove excess mulch from around base of perennials and shrubs and work some into the surrounding soil.
6. Fertilize as needed.
