Mayor's Message

There are many projects going on this summer. The City is extending pressurized secondary water under I-15 to connect to the line in S.R. 126 (2000 West) which will service the businesses along that road and conserve our drinking water from being used for irrigation. Road projects will also be starting around the City as we plan for the future and conduct seasonal maintenance.

The City Council adopted the balanced budgets proposed by the administration at their June meeting. The City maintains a good reserve and continues to operate with no debt and no property tax.

The City continued to clean debris from storm drains and waterways around the community this spring to alleviate flood potential. Thanks to the many residents who helped on this project. The cool spring weather helped slow the flow of the spring run-off and prevent banks from overrunning on our many waterways. Enjoy the summer without any drought restrictions.

We are coming upon firework season. There is no fireworks restrictions other than state law. Weber Fire District asks that you please be safe and respectful when using fireworks.

Local Updates

- ▶ **Utilities.** Garbage rates were increased earlier this year to account for a shortfall in revenues compared to expenses. All other City utilities remain the same.
- ▶ **Central Weber Sewer.** Central Weber Sewer Improvement District adopted a rate increase. For more information call Central Weber Sewer District at 801-731-3011.
- ▶ **Secondary Water.** The City pressurized irrigation system will be treated with potassium to clear the lines of bryozoa. Pink dye is used to help staff see that the treatment has circulated the water system. Only use secondary water for irrigation purposes.
- ▶ **Garbage.** Do not overfill your garbage cans. It creates litter and is illegal. Lids must close.
