## Yard Waste and Storm Water

Storm water can carry pollutants from our lawn and garden into our water system. We all want to drink clean and safe water. Here are some tips to protect our water from contamination:

- Apply fertilizers only when necessary and at the recommended amount.
- Avoid fertilizing near waterways or storm drains.
- Avoid over-watering lawns and gardens as this can wash fertilizer into the water system.
- Fill fertilizer spreaders on a hard surface so spills can easily be cleaned up.
- Properly store and dispose unused fertilizers.
- Use native plants, shrubs, and trees to reduce water use and fertilizer.
- Recycle yard waste, grass clippings, and leaves.
- Never place clippings or yard debris in a storm drain, waterway, or ditch.
- Mulch and compost.
- Properly dispose of yard waste.
- Never dispose oil, fuel, fertilizer, or anything else in any storm drain.

Contamination in our water can cause severe and permanent health problems. The storm water systems are designed for storm water only. Help keep our water clean.

## **Local Updates**

- Utilities. Garbage rates were increased earlier this year. All other City utilities remain the same.
- Central Weber Sewer. Central Weber Sewer Improvement District is proposing a property tax increase and set a Public Hearing on August 19, 2024, at 6:00 PM at its District office, 2618 West Pioneer Road.
- Secondary Water. The City pressurized irrigation system is treated with potassium to clear the lines of bryozoa. Pink dye is used to help staff see that the treatment has circulated the water system. The system will be shut down for 24-hours during treatment. Only use secondary water for irrigation purposes.
- Garbage. Do not overfill your garbage cans. It creates litter and is illegal. Lids must close.
