Christmas Message

from the Mayor and City Council We enter the holiday season again with hopes of starting the new year. At this time, Marriott-Slaterville City reflects on accomplishments in 2024.

Spring 2024 brought a lot of rain and City Officials made preparations as talk of flooding rumbled around the county. Preparations included replacing storm drain lines that were old and under capacity near 700 South, and cleaning overgrowth on Mill Creek to allow for proper drainage. Ultimately, rivers and streams handled the spring run-off and the community rested easy as the summer heat wave took over.

Marriott Park saw several of its cottonwood trees dying from old age. Four trees were removed to make way for new trees in the coming year. Slaterville Park was converted to pressurized irrigation to optimize and conserve water. The pressurized irrigation line on 400 North was extended under I-15 to 1900 West to connect additional businesses and allow for future expansion down Pioneer Road.

This year the City dedicated the Historical Smout Cabin relocated to City Hall Park. The cabin displays pioneer era artifacts and is dedicated to the legacy our ancestors contributed in the early days of settlement.

Winter Roads

Winter will soon be coming to Northern Utah. It is time to remember some rules for the road. Remember no parking on any roads between midnight and 7:00 AM between December 1 and March 1, during a snowstorm, and seventy-two (72) hours after a snowstorm. This is so the snow plows can operate. Violators will be towed. The most traveled roads are plowed first. Subdivisions and lesser traveled roads are plowed last. Property owners with sidewalks are responsible to remove snow from the sidewalk within twenty-four (24) hours after a snowstorm.
