As this new year begins, my commitment to this community will continue as it has throughout my term as Mayor. When I propose the 2025-26 budget this coming June, there will again be no property tax. Last year, we celebrated our 25th Anniversary as Marriott-Slaterville City having never imposed a property tax. I am proud of this achievement, and intend to continue it.

Our new year brings us a great achievement. Marriott-Slaterville City is being considered for one of the best well-managed cities in Utah with a population under 10,000. Some of our local leaders were interviewed last month by a national magazine about this achievement. I hope to get you more information about our successes as this new year progresses. I also note that the City received the Health Utah Community Award for the second time. This Award is for our efforts in making the community a better and more healthy place to live.

In 2025, the City will be working on a major construction project to install sewer and upgrade utilities on 1700 South. This will be followed by a reconstruction of 1700 South and part of 1200 West south of the railroad tracks. I anticipate there will be a lot of disruptions to residents, businesses, and traffic during this utility work and reconstruction of the road. Please be patient as construction occurs. 1700 South, in its current state, has many deficiencies. I look forward to successfully completing this project and reopening the new street.

As the state grows, it has been a priority of our local officials to keep our traditions and values. These challenging times make it difficult and I ask for your continued support in our community planning, conservation programs, and agriculture preservation efforts.
